## The FREIGHT Act of 2010 "Focusing Resources, Economic Investment, and **Guidance to Help** Transportation Act of 2010"

Introduced by Congressman Albio Sires (NJ-13) as the House companion to Senator Lautenberg's legislation

### NJ-13 Congressional District

- Includes the cities of Hoboken, Jersey City, Bayonne and parts of Newark
- Mass transit
- Port Newark-Elizabeth Marine Terminal
- Nearby Newark Airport

## Need for Comprehensive Freight Policy

By 2035, the Department of Transportation predicts that total freight tonnage transported will nearly double & that:

- Tons transported by truck will grow by 98%
- Tons transported by rail will grow by 88%

## FREIGHT ACT:

### (1) Freight Transportation Policy

- To improve the <u>efficiency</u>, <u>operation</u>, and <u>security</u> of the national transportation system to move freight
- Sets forth objectives and goals related to:
- Energy conservation
- Public safety & health
- Economic competitiveness

# FREIGHT ACT: (2) Office of Freight Planning and Development

Dedicated office within the U.S. Department of Transportation to:

- Coordinate
- Facilitate
- Support

## FREIGHT ACT: National Strategic Plan

- A long-term plan would include:
- Assessment of the current system,
- Analysis of emerging trends
- Description of major challenges
- Plan to develop priorities & strategy to develop coalitions
- Guidelines to finance the system
- List of priority freight corridors & gateways

# FREIGHT ACT: Transportation Investment Planning Tools

- Outcome-oriented, performance-based approach to evaluate proposed projects
- Consultation with Federal, State, and local transportation planners

## (3) National Freight Infrastructure Investment Grants

 Competitive grant program for eligible projects including: port development, multimodal terminal facilities, and

intelligent transportation systems

- Criteria
- Priority
- Oversight

#### **FREIGHT ACT**

- Currently supported by the Coalition for America's Gateways and Trade Corridors, Environmental Defense Fund, Intelligent Transportation Society of America, T4America and others.
- Goal: Incorporate language into the surface transportation reauthorization bill
