NJ Clean Energy Program - Background

- Introduced 2001 as part of the NJ "Clean Energy Act" of 1999
- Funded from "Societal Benefits Charge" on utility bill
- Administered by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities
- Provides energy efficiency project opportunities for:
 - Residential
 - Commercial & Industrial TRC Energy Services
 - Renewable Energy







NJ Clean Energy Program & Building Performance with ENERGY STAR

- "Umbrella" approach to integrating Building Performance with ENERGY STAR
- Synergy between state and national EE goals
- Pay for Performance (P4P) Program and Building Performance with ENERGY STAR goals are complementary
- NJ Sector Specific benchmarking initiative enhanced by Building Performance with ENERGY STAR partnership offering
- Building Performance with ENERGY STAR has a market introduction venue via P4P

Integration with ENERGY STAR


- Portfolio Manager is a fundamental Pilot Program offering
- Portfolio Manager is fully integrated into the NJ Clean Energy Programs
 - Sector Specific provides energy benchmarking with PM
 - Pay for Performance
- Pay for Performance Program uses PM to:
 - Establish baseline and determine 15% minimum savings threshold projection
 - Verify actual savings levels







Pay for Performance - Participation







NJ Clean Energy Program Pilot Results to Date

- Nine Program Participants
 - 55 Facility Locations
 - More than 2 million square feet
 - 12 P4P Projects
 - 2.9 million kWh in electric savings
 - 19% average source energy reduction



EPA Benchmark Scores for Portfolio




