The Manufactured Housing Market

- Nearly 9 million homes or ~6% of housing market (varies by region)
- 80% of manufactured home owners are low-income, and 28% living below the poverty line
- ~60% of manufactured homes in use today are over 20 years old



Energy use in Manufactured Homes

- Account for ~5% of residential energy consumption
- Energy bills average \$1,500 annually, but can reach hundreds per month in extreme climates and aging homes
