Nancy Lange was appointed Commissioner to the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission by Governor Mark Dayton, effective March 4, 2013, and appointed Chair, January 23, 2017.

Chair Lange is a member of the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (NARUC) and is Chair of its Committee on Energy Resources and the Environment. She also serves on the NARUC Committee on Washington Action. Chair Lange is a member of the Midcontinent States Environmental and Energy Regulators (MSEER) group and currently serves as its Chair. She also serves as a member of the Mid-America Regulatory Conference (MARC).

Prior to her appointment, Chair Lange served as Manager of Policy and Engagement at the Center for Energy and Environment. Ms. Lange holds a B.S. from Iowa State University and M.A. in Public Policy from the University of Minnesota. Her term will expire on January 7, 2019.
