


What is motivating the Pharmaceutical industry to improve energy efficiency?

- A focus on reducing Greenhouse Gas emissions
 - Merck global GHG emission reduction target is a 15% absolute reduction of 2012 CO₂ emission levels by 2020
 - The majority of the GHG emission reductions will come from energy efficiency improvements
- Increasing cost & global volatility of energy supply






Energy Intensity is Decreasing


