

Dr. Ian Hamilton is an Associate Professor at the UCL Energy Institute, University College London, UK, and an Energy Analyst at the International Energy Agency in Paris. His research is focused on the nexus between energy demand, energy efficiency, indoor and urban environment, and health and climate change. Ian is the Principle Investigator for IEA's *Annex 70 - Building Energy Epidemiology* which includes researchers from 25 institutions from 12 countries.

Ian is a Co-investigator on the *Centre on Research for Energy Demand Solutions* where Ian leads the energy, health and resilience group, and a Co-I on UK's Health Protection Research Unit - *Healthy and Sustainable Cities under Climate Change*. Ian is leading a project with the UK Government to quantify the health impact of introducing energy efficiency measures in the UK's housing stock using health surveys and building retrofit programme data.

Ian is the lead on energy, climate change mitigation and health on the *Lancet Countdown: Tracking Progress on Health and Climate Change*. Ian is widely published in his field including a number of high-profile Lancet Commissions on climate change and health.
